

Green Lake Township Regular Board Meeting

February 8, 2010

Called to order: 6:00 p.m. by Supervisor, Biondo.

Roll Call: Radtke, Bieganowski, Schroeter, West, McDonald, Dinger, Biondo, present.

Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Agenda: Moved McDonald, Support West to approve the agenda as amended with the addition of bike path under postponed business. Carried.

Consent Agenda: Moved Radtke, Support Bieganowski to approve 1/11/10 & 1/20/10 minutes, bills in the amount of \$61,630.26, treasurer's report – on hand general fund \$196,307.52, other funds \$1,034,432.27, receipts GF \$172,359.72, disbursements \$49,050.25, ending balance GF \$331,855.16. Reports: Sheriff's Dept.: Deputy Clark reported 218 complaints for January 2010.

EMS/FD: Pruyne reported 7 fire and 19 ambulance responses, ongoing training for fire and EMS in February, M. Stinson was promoted to deputy fire chief for GTRFD.

County Commissioner: Thomas stated the county board revised the meeting schedule from 6 to 4 meetings per month.

Planner: L Sickterman reported a draft master plan has been put together, working on P&R Plan and upcoming zoning amendments.

J. Knol: Knol presented the board with a revised conceptual drawing for a new fire station and renovation of township hall, using existing building.

B. Osterhout: Osterhout presented a solid waste services study done by GBB consulting firm.
