Called to order: 6:00 p.m. by Supervisor, Biondo.

Agenda: Moved Radtke, Support Dinger to approve as presented. Carried.

Planner: Sickterman reported Master Plan was sent as required by the law and the planning commission is working on ordinance amendments.

Commission On Aging: R. Harrand presented a break down of services for the elderly provided by the commission.
