

Green Lake Township Regular Board Meeting

October 12, 2009

Called to Order 6:00 p.m. by Supervisor, Biondo.

Roll Call: Radtke, Schroeter, Bieganowski, West, McDonald, Dinger, Biondo, present.

Pledge of Allegance to the Flag.

Agenda: Moved Radtke, Support West to approve the agenda with the addition of G. T. County Planning Award. Carried.

Consent Agenda: Moved Radtke, Support Schroeter to approve with the following corrections to 9/14/09 minutes – insert NO PUBLIC COMMENT after public hearing for Rainbow Pond, correct Atwell Mawby spelling change to OTWELL MAWBY under Survey/Geotechnical Soils Tests, bills in the amount of \$181,151.03 (this includes GL Water & St. Point Sewer System), treasurer's report – on hand general fund 9/1/09 \$246,104.77, other funds \$795,273.33, receipts GF \$74,014.33, disbursements GF \$61,108.61. Carried.
