

**MINUTES**  
**GREEN LAKE TOWNSHIP PLANNING COMMISSION MEETING**  
**January 25, 2010**

Call to order: 6:32 PM

Roll Call: Dave Pennington, Elizabeth Disbrow, Hugo Karle, Chris Hintz, Jon Schuster, Gerry Jackowski and Pat McDonald present.

Approval of the agenda: Motion made by Jackowski and seconded by McDonald to amend the agenda to include under New Business "Explanation of Jackowski absence for next month". Motion carried. Motion made by Pennington and seconded by Karle to approve the agenda with approved amendment. Motion carried.

Also present was Krysti Baker, Zoning Administrator and Leslie Sickterman, Planner.

There were 2 members of the public present.

Approval of the minutes: Motion made by Penninton and seconded by Karle to approve the minutes of the October 26, 2009 meeting. Motion carried.

New Business:

Explanation of Jackowski's absence for next month.

Jackowski explained that he will be absent for next month's meeting but would like to be considered for Chairman at the elections.

Request from Brian McAllister to have an electronic message sign at the Hofbrau.

Mr. McAllister explained the LED sign that he would like to install. He handed out drawing of a concept but has other ideas he would like to pursue. The LED sign would be 21 sq. ft. and the name would be 16 sq. ft.

The Zoning Ordinance only allows for a 16 sq. ft. sign so a variance would be needed for the size. The Planning Commission is to review the sign to make sure it is not a traffic hazard. The Planning Commission cannot approve at this meeting because of the lack of information.

Motion made by Hintz and seconded by Jackowski to table indefinitely until applicant request to be on agenda. Motion carried.

Unfinished Business:

Update of MASTER PLAN

Sickterman has put together the full document and added the village plan elements to the Master Plan. There was discussion on how to move forward from here. The Planning Commissioners are going to identify issues from the Master Plan and submit to Baker by February 15 to be included in the packet for February's meeting. The Planning Commission will then decide how they want to address the issues.
