

Green Lake Township Regular Board Meeting

September 12, 2011

Called to order: 6:00 p.m. by Supervisor, Biondo.

Roll Call: Radtke, West, McDonald, Bieganowski, Schroeter, Dinger, Biondo, present.

Agenda: Moved Radtke, Support Bieganowski to approve with the addition of Springfield Roof Proposals. Carried.

Consent Agenda: Moved Bieganowski, Support West to approve 8/8/11 minutes bills in the amount of \$98,312.24, pre authorized payment list, treasurer's report – on hand general fund 8/1/11 \$435,595.65, other funds \$967,801.70, receipts \$33,026.56, disbursements \$74,363.02. Ending balance 8/31/11 general fund \$394,259.18. Carried.

Reports: FD/EMS – H. Smith reported department continues training, 13 fire and 41 ambulance responses for August.

County Commissioner: Thomas reported they are working on cutting the budget, discussion regarding laying 12 custodians and hiring a private company. County Board of Commissioners still discussing possible special assessment versus raising fees for the septage facility. Discussion regarding injection well and public hearing 9/14/11.

Senior/Community Center: S. Neumann and N. Watkins explained programs and activities that are or will be available at the Golden Fellowship Hall. Some programs are free, some are by donation only and some have a fixed fee.

Correspondence: On file.

New Business: Cherry Growers – J. Sluis representing Cherry Growers and Materne North America explained the new product they will be producing at the Grawn Plant. (Green Lake Township needs to schedule a public hearing regarding the applications for Industrial Tax Exemption), Moved Bieganowski, Support Radtke to schedule October 10, 2011 at 6:00 p.m. for the public hearing. Carried.

Ordinance (animals): Moved Radtke, Support West to send the sample information to the planning commission. Carried.

Holidays: Moved Bieganowski, Support Schroeter to designate 12/26/11 as Christmas Eve, 12/27/11 as Christmas Day, 12/29/11 as New Year's Day and Close Township for office staff on 12/29/11. Carried.

Award Nomination: Moved Radtke, Support Bieganowski to send to the Zoning Administrator and Planner for recommendations for the County Planning Award. Carried.

School Building (Interlochen): Moved Radtke, Support Bieganowski to direct the supervisor to hire some professional services to inspect the building. Carried.

EDC: Moved Bieganowski, Support Radtke to postpone The Economic Development Corporation until October 10, 2001. Carried.

Springfield Roof Proposals: Moved Bieganowski, Support Schroeter to approve the Library Roof proposal as presented. Carried. Moved Schroeter, Support Radtke to approve the Township Office/EMS Building proposal as presented. Carried.

Questions & Comments: West commented that PEG Revenues was postponed, but not on the agenda (Dinger stated a letter was written, with no response), also painter Pat, was an ad written (Dinger stated, not so far).
